SPEAKER GUIDELINES

Thank you for your interest in speaking at our FCBPW luncheon event. We hope the following guidelines will be useful to you as you prepare your presentation.

Remember FCBPW's Purpose

To present Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord to business and professional women (Christians and non-Christians) and to encourage Christian business and professional women to carry out their faith in the workplace.

This forum is for women of faith and a place for non-Christian co-workers and friends to get a glimpse of today's Christian women in action. Please realize non-Christian women are present as well.

Speak from an Experiential Point of View

Our program structure is for you to tell our guests how you found the Lord and how you integrate your faith in the workplace. We encourage you to share personally how God has brought you through struggles as well as victories in your life as it helps women in your audience identify with you and also be encouraged by you.

A Gentle Reminder to Avoid the Following Possible Pitfalls

When communicating the Gospel and relating your Christian experience with the group, please keep in mind your audience. Please do your best to **avoid** the following:

- Theological terms and clichés words we understand and hold dear may not be as familiar or not familiar at all to non-Christians. If religious terms are used, they should be fully explained. Be simple and clear.
- **Promoting** a church, program, project ministry or political party no matter how worthy.
- **Emphasizing specific habits** such as smoking, drinking, gambling, etc. so you don't leave the impression that giving up these habits makes you a Christian, nor do we want imply that habits must be changed before a person can become a Christian.
- **Put Downs** don't "put down" or even mention in a negative way particular denominations, political parties, ethnic groups, individuals or anything else that might offend a guest.

Please Do the Following in Preparation for Your Speaking Engagement

- Please submit a one-page bio and picture as soon as possible to the FBCPW to publish in our promotional materials for the event.
- Please let us know if you plan to distribute handouts or use equipment (such as LCD panel, etc.). All handouts need to be approved by the Board.
- Please let us know if you have any special dietary requirements or need assistance in any way with wheelchair access for you or your invited guests.
- Please plan to arrive early to spend a short time in prayer with members of the Board of Directors. Please confirm how early you should arrive with your Program Committee Contact.
- Please plan to spend a few moments after your presentation to answer questions and converse with attendees.

We hope this helps you prepare for our event. The **FCBPW Board of Directors** will be praying for you, both now and during your presentation.
